The end of the disease era

The time has come to abandon disease as the focus of medical care. The changed spectrum of health, the complex interplay of biological and nonbiological factors, the aging population, and the interindividual variability in health priorities render medical care that is centered on the diagnosis and treatment of individual diseases at best out of date and at worst harmful.

A primary focus on disease may inadvertently lead to undertreatment, overtreatment, or mistreatment. The numerous strategies that have evolved to address the limitations of the disease model, although laudable, are offered only to a select subset of persons and often further fragment care. Clinical decision making for all patients should be predicated on the attainment of individual goals and the identification and treatment of all modifiable biological and nonbiological factors, rather than solely on the diagnosis, treatment, or prevention of individual diseases. Anticipated arguments against a more integrated and individualized approach range from concerns about medicalization of life problems to "this is nothing new" and "resources would be better spent determining the underlying biological mechanisms." The perception that the disease model is "truth" rather than a previously useful model will be a barrier as well.

Notwithstanding these barriers, medical care must evolve to meet the health care needs of patients in the 21st century.

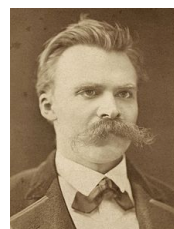
While there is only little consensus on an AD-specific personality profile and its etiological significance, a growing number of reports support the role of psychosocial stress in the onset and the course of Atopic Dermatitis symptomatology.

Psychosomatic Medicine

In Germany Psychosomatic medicine is not a synonym for consultation-liason Psychiatry but represents a comprehensive field (Fava GA et al, Curr Psychiatry Rep 2010;12:215-21) as well as a specialised medical field (Deter HC, Adv Psychosom Med 2004;26,181-189).

The clinical core competency of German Psychosomatic medicine is centred on integrated care for the following disorders: somatoform / functional disorders, eating disorders, somatopsychic disorders including psycho-oncology, psychocardiology, neuro-psychosomatics, psychodiabetology and psycho-traumatology. An overlap with psychiatry exists in the fields of depressive, anxiety, and personality disorders. (Psycother Psychosom 2016;85:262-269).

Friedrich Wilhelm Nietzsche



15 October 1844 – 25 August 1900) was a German philosopher, cultural critic, poet, philologist, whose work has exerted a profound influence on Western philosophy and modern intellectual history.

Probably the greatest philosopher ever yet, to stir up the thought process of the maximum no. of human beings, agreement or disagreement with his ideas and opinions apart, was born in the family of clergy men and christened to become the severest critic of Christianity. Unfortunately, his concepts of 'will to power' and 'overman/superman' were badly distorted by nazis for their propaganda. Most remember him as only a nihilist. Still doubtful how many understood his most famous quote. 'God is dead . You (man) killed Him '.

His genius can be understood from the fact that he became a university professor of philosophy at the age of 24 ! He died as an insane man at the age of 56. Seeing the current world he might have died at much a younger age !
